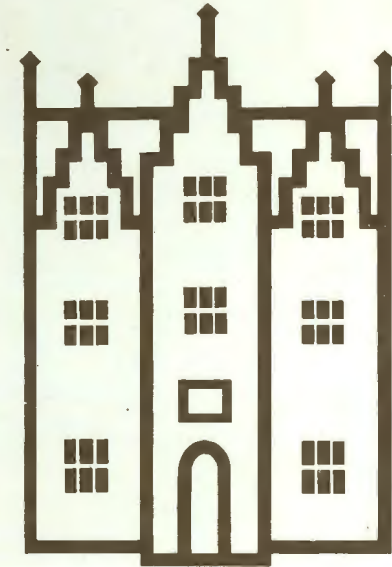

THE SAXON BARTON PRIZE. This is brought to the notice of young artists associated with the Principality.

This prize is offered annually for the best work submitted to the Summer Exhibition by an artist who is not a member of a recognised Academy of Art or Art Society, and under 30 years of age, with the object of encouraging such artists to exhibit their work.
