

Because of the increasing interest shown by locals and visitors in this 16th century town house, which is occupied by The Royal Cambrian Academy of Art, the society was established in 1978 with the primary aim of raising funds to help towards the cost of its preservation.

The Academy signed its first lease on Plas Mawr in 1886 and the house has remained its headquarters since that date.

To ensure that it will continue to be so for many years to come, the society—by its various activities—aims to foster interest in the house and liaison between the artist members of the Academy and the general public.

Meetings are held on the 2nd Monday for eight months of the year and fundraising activities, social gatherings and lectures are organized during the year.

Membership subscription—a minimum of £1.00 per year—entitles you to:

- 1. Free Admission to the house
- 2. Admission to all Private Views and Opening Days of Academy exhibitions—no invitation cards will be sent.
- 3. At least one Newsletter per annum and information on all other social activities arranged by the Society.
