Rhagair gan y Llywydd

A short history of the Royal Cambrian Academy

In the late 19th Century, North Wales was home to the first artists' colony in Britain. It emerged from the summer sojourns of David Cox at Betws-y-Coed between 1844 and 1856, and by 1881 the Conwy Valley was at the peak of its fame as a home and a resort for large numbers of professional and amateur painters. The prospect of viewing artists at work attracted thousands of visitors, and Llandudno emerged as a centre for the sale of pictures.

The seven men who launched the Academy were all devotees of the artists' colony, most of them originally from the North West of England from where Betws-y-Coed had become easily accessible by train. They were John Johnson of Trefriw, Charles Potter of Tal-y-Bont, and three of the 'Manchester' School residing in the Conwy Valley, William Meredith, Joshua Anderson Hague and George Hayes. Their elected chairman was Edwin Arthur Norbury and Secretary William L. Banks of Conwy. They met at the Llandudno Junction Hotel on 12th November 1881 and drew up a prospectus which was published two weeks later :-

"The Royal Academy and other institutions of similar character have long been established in England, the Royal Hibernian Academy in Ireland, the Scottish Academy in Scotland, but Wales has hitherto felt the want of a kindred society of its own. It has therefore been resolved to establish 'The Cambrian Academy of Art' in the hope that such an Institution will give impetus to the further development of Art in connection with the Principality."

By January 1882, the thirty-one founding members of the Academy had been accepted, along with eight associates, and three months later the influence of Mr Gladstone secured royal patronage from Queen Victoria. The first Exhibition of the Royal Cambrian Academy opened on 20th June 1882 in temporary premises in Llandudno, where 129 works by 35 artists were shown. The membership had continued to expand after the original deadline for applications to join, the most notable newcomer being the distinguished painter Henry Clarence Whaite. A decision on the application of Carrie Walker to join the Academy in 1882 was deferred, for effectively the new institution operated a men-only policy.

Unlike the English cities of Manchester and Liverpool, Wales had no purpose built art gallery, and the question of a home exercised members through the first few years. There were efforts to establish a permanent gallery in Cardiff, but two

exhibitions there in 1884 and 1885 were financially disastrous and alternative venues included Bangor, Rhyl and even Conwy Castle! Then Lord Mostyn offered the Royal Cambrian Academy a permanent home in Plas Mawr in Conwy. It was in a dilapidated state, in part occupied by an infant school and a stable. However on June 4th 1886, the Royal Cambrian Academy moved into its new premises. That year the Summer Exhibition included Leighton's 'Cimabue's Madonna carried through Florence', on loan from Queen Victoria, a portrait by Alma-Tadema and Millais' 'Blind Girl' on loan from the Mayor of Conwy, Albert Woods. In 1888 the Academy marked the Queen's Jubilee by presenting her with two albums of watercolours by fifty-one members, the first being exclusively of Welsh landscapes.

Finally the Academy had a home and a sound financial base, although the fabric of Plas Mawr needed constant attention, and during the following years, a thorough restoration at the Academy's expense was undertaken under the direction of the Secretary, William L. Banks. But however beautiful the newly restored Plas Mawr had become, it was highly unsuitable as an art gallery. It was decided at a meeting on February 12th 1895 to put up a 'temporary building on good foundations' in the garden of Plas Mawr. The exhibition gallery, a wooden framed, slate roofed, top-lit building on wooden piers was completed in October 1895 and named the 'Victoria Gallery'. It was opened with a grand fancy dress ball on February 11th 1896. A hundred years later (almost to the day of its inception), in February 1995 the same wooden building which had served the Academy so well, was knocked down as part of the refurbishment of Plas Mawr.

The much improved hanging space provided by the Victoria Gallery had resulted in bigger exhibitions with as many as five hundred works, including submissions by non-members, being hung. Much of this organisational progress was due to the Academy's first President, Henry Clarence Whaite. He was a man of great enthusiasm and energy who had trained in Manchester and the Royal Academy Schools, who exhibited widely and later also became President of the Manchester Academy of Fine Arts. In 1998, an exhibition of his work, originated by the National Library of Wales and curated by Peter Lord and David Mortimer-Jones, toured widely in Wales, culminating at the Royal Cambrian Academy in Conwy. This allowed a new generation to see many of his powerful oil paintings and watercolours.

The next president was Sir Cuthbert Grundy, whose 21 years as president saw a continuation of the grand scale Annual Summer Exhibitions, widely supported and selling well, although they were often criticised in the press as not being particularly adventurous! Grundy commissioned a commemorative

medallion to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Academy in 1932. When he retired in 1934, Augustus John became President. However, having been present for his election, life having too much to offer elsewhere, he never attended another meeting. He was replaced in 1939 with Richard Hinchcliffe. The balance was redressed however, when, in 1997, an exhibition of John's drawings, which was curated by his granddaughter, Rebecca John RCA, the National Galleries of Wales and the London gallery, Spinks, opened in London and then toured Wales. Its final venue was in the Royal Cambrian Academy, where it was a spectacular success, drawing thousands of visitors.

The following years saw women on the Council, a change of royal patron to HM the Queen Mother in 1952 and the usual successful Annual Summer Exhibitions. However, the high costs of looking after Plas Mawr had become an onerous burden for the Academy and changes needed to be made. In 1972 the President, Kyffin Williams, sought to encourage the Academicians to move out of Plas Mawr, having secured Oriel Mostyn in Llandudno as a new base. Despite the many advantages of this move, he was unable to persuade the Academicians, and resigned in protest.

In 1991 the Conwy Tunnel was opened and this meant changes for everyone within the walls of Conwy. With the end of traffic congestion there was a wonderful opportunity for Conwy to welcome visitors in a quiet atmosphere, largely unknown in the previous thirty years. Discussions took place between Cadw, Lord Mostyn and the Academy with a view to passing the tenancy of Plas Mawr to Cadw, who spent two years refurbishing the building before re-opening it to the public as a fine example of an Elizabethan town mansion. Next door to the Victoria Gallery was a chapel, Capel Seion, which was empty and sadly neglected. After protracted negotiations between the RCA, working with architect Skip Belton, Conwy County Borough Council, Geoffrey Edwards of Project Conwy, Cadw and the Wales Tourist Board, a new purpose built gallery was created. Its first exhibition opened on June 12th 1993.

With the move came other changes. Ray Fields resigned as President in 1992, having held the office since 1983, and, after a period of transition for the Academy under the guidance of David Hillhouse, Kyffin Williams took on the Presidency for a second time. In 1993, I joined the Academy as Curator on the retirement of Sylvia and Leonard Mercer. Kyffin Williams undertook a programme of bringing in artist members from all over Wales, with a concentration on South and Mid Wales, raising the number of members to over a hundred. He and the Council introduced a programme of nine exhibitions a year. New links were forged with other galleries in Wales, and the Academy, for the first time in many years, sent an exhibition to

the National Museums and Galleries of Wales in Cardiff. They reciprocated by allowing important collections to come to Conwy, as did the National Library of Wales. A new 'Friends of the RCA' was formed with the help and guidance of Anne Forrest, Lauren Lindee and chairman, Michael Senior. The support of the Friends has been invaluable and the funds they have raised have been put back into the gallery in many different ways to enhance the exhibition and educational programmes.

The Academy now has an all year round exhibition programme and the gallery, because of its large and elegant space, is also an excellent venue for lectures, book launches and slide shows. Every private view draws at least 100 people and every exhibition, on average, nearly 2000 visitors. Funding comes from Conwy County Borough Council, Conwy Town Council, the Arts Council of Wales, some small but generous local trusts and, of course the Academy itself. Continuing the long tradition in Plas Mawr, art classes fill the gallery on Wednesdays with landscape painting taken by lecturer Jeremy Yates and life drawing in the evenings with David Loten. The open Annual Summer Exhibition continues to draw both artists and the summer crowds, with sales of paintings rising year on year.

The knighthood bestowed on the President Sir Kyffin Williams in 1999 was a great honour, raising the already high profile of the President and the Academy, and, in what was a very successful year for the Academy, Gwyneth Jones took over as Curator. Sadly in 2002 HM Queen Elizabeth, the Queen Mother, who had been a generous and thoughtful patron, died aged 101.

As we look towards the future for the Royal Cambrian Academy we hope that it will be as secure and steadfast as the last 120 years. We are confident that the artist members will continue to prove that art in Wales is flourishing and that the Academy remains a significant force in that endeavour.

Hanes yr Academi Frenhinol Gymreig yn gryno

Yn ail hanner y 19eg ganrif, roedd Gogledd Cymru yn gartref i'r wladfa arlunwyr gyntaf ym Mhrydain. Canlyniad ymwelliadau David Cox â Betws-y-Coed dros yr haf rhwng 1844 ac 1856 oedd hyn, ac erbyn 1881 roedd enwogrwydd Dyffryn Conwy fel cartref a chanolfan i nifer fawr o arlunwyr proffesiynol ac amatur ar ei anterth. Roedd y gobaith o weld artistiaid wrth eu gwaith yn denu miloedd o ymwelwyr, a daeth Llandudno i amlygrwydd fel canolfan gwerthu lluniau.

Roedd y saith dyn a lansiodd yr Academi i gyd yn aelodau brwd o'r wladfa arlunwyr. Deuai'r rhan fwyaf ohonynt yn wreiddiol o Ogledd Orllewin Lloegr ac erbyn y cyfnod hwn roedd Betws-y-Coed o fewn cyrraedd hwylus ar y trén. Y saith oedd John Johnson o Drefriw, Charles Potter o Dal-y-Bont, a thri aelod o Ysgol 'Manceinion' a oedd yn byw yn Nyffryn Conwy, sef William Meredith, Joshua Anderson Hague a George Hayes. Edwin Arthur Norbury oedd eu Cadeirydd etholedig a William L. Banks o Gonwy oedd yr Ysgrifennydd. Cyfarfuont yn y Llandudno Junction Hotel ar y 12fed Tachwedd 1881 gan lunio prospectws a gafodd ei gyhoeddi bythefnos yn ddiweddarach :-

"The Royal Academy and other institutions of similar character have long been established in England, the Royal Hibernian Academy in Ireland, the Scottish Academy in Scotland, but Wales has hitherto felt the want of a kindred society of its own. It has therefore been resolved to establish 'The Cambrian Academy of Art' in the hope that such an Institution will give impetus to the further development of Art in connection with the Principality."

Erbyn Ionawr 1992, roedd un aelod ar ddeg ar hugain cychwynnol yr Academi wedi cael eu derbyn, ynghyd ag wyth aelod cysylltiol, a thri mis yn ddiweddarach sicrhaoedd dylanwad Mr Gladstone nawddogaeth frenhinol y Frenhines Fictoria i'r fenter. Agorwyd Arddangosfa gyntaf yr Academi Frenhinol Gymreig ar yr 20fed Mehefin 1882 mewn ystafelloedd dros dro yn Llandudno, lle'r arddangoswyd 129 o weithiau gan 35 o arlunwyr. Parhaodd yr aelodaeth i gynyddu ar ôl y dyddiad cau gwreiddiol ar gyfer ymuno, a'r newydd-ddyfodol amlycaf oedd yr arlunydd adnabyddus Henry Clarence Whaite. Gohiriwyd penderfynu ar gais Carrie Walker i ymuno â'r Academi yn 1882, am fod y sefydliad newydd mewn gwirionedd yn gweithredu polisi 'dynion yn unig'.

Yn wahanol i ddinasoedd Manceinion a Lerpwl yn Lloegr, nid oedd gan Gymru oriel gelf wedi'i chodi'n bwrpasol, ac roedd sicrhau cartref i'r Academi yn fater a achosodd grym benbleth i'r aelodau yn y blynnyddoedd cyntaf. Ceisiwyd sefydlu oriel barhaol yng Nghaerdydd, ond bu dwy arddangosfa a gynhalwyd yno yn 1884 ac 1885 yn fethiant trychinebus yn ariannol ac ymseg y lleoliadau eraill a ystyriwyd yn lle Caerdydd roedd Bangor, y Rhyl a hyd yn oed Castell Conwy! Yna, cynigiodd yr Arglywyd Mostyn gartref parhaol i'r Academi Frenhinol Gymreig ym Mhlas Mawr yng Nghonwy. Roedd yr adeilad mewn cyflwr gwael, a'rhan ohono'n cael ei ddefnyddio gan ysgol babanod a stabl. Fodd bynnag, ar y 4ydd Mehefin 1886, symudodd yr Academi Frenhinol Gymreig i'w chartref newydd. Y flwyddyn honno roedd Arddangosfa'r Haf yn cynnwys 'Cimabue's Madonna carried through Florence' gan Leighton, ar fenthyg oddi wrth y Frenhines Fictoria, portread gan Alma-Tadema a 'Blind Girl' gan Millais, ar fenthyg oddi wrth Faer Conwy, Albert Woods. Yn 1888 dynododd yr Academi Jiwbil'i'r Frenhines drwy gyflwyno dalaubwm o luniau dyfrlliw gan hanner cant ac un o aelodau iddi, gyda'r cyntaf yn cynnwys dim ond tirluniau o Gymru.

O'r diwedd roedd gan yr Academi gartref a seiliau ariannol cadarn, er bod angen sylw parhaus ar adeiladwaith Plas Mawr, a thros y blynnyddoedd dilynol gwnaed gwaith adfer cynhwysfawr arno ar draul yr Academi, o dan gyfarwyddyd yr Ysgrifennydd, William L. Banks. Ond er mor hardd oedd Plas Mawr ar ei newydd wedd, roedd yn gwbl anaddas fel oriel gelf. Mewn cyfarfod ar y 12fed Chwefror 1895, penderfynwyd codi 'adeilad dros dro ar sylfeini cadarn' yng ngardd Plas Mawr. Cwblhawyd yr oriel arddangos, adeilad ffwrdd bren, to llechi, wedi'i oleuo o'r top, ar bileri pren, ym mis Hydref 1895 ac fe'i henwyd yn 'Oriel Fictoria'. Agorwyd yr oriel gyda dawns gwisg ffansi fawreddog ar yr 11eg Chwefror 1896. Gan mlynedd yn ddiweddarach (i ddiwrnod ei sefydlu bron), ym mis Chwefror 1995 cafodd yr un adeilad pren, a oedd wedi gwasanaethu'r Academi gystal, ei ddymchwel fel rhan o'r gwaith o adnewyddu Plas Mawr.

Gyda'r cyfleusterau hongian llawer rhagorach yn Oriel Fictoria roedd modd cynnal arddangosfeydd llawer mwy ac roedd cynifer â phum cant o weithiau, yn cynnwys eitemau gan arlunwyr nad oeddent yn aelodau, yn cael eu hongian. Roedd llawer o'r cynnydd trefniadaethol hwn i'w briodoli i Lywydd cyntaf yr Academi, Henry Clarence Whaite. Roedd yn ddyn llawn brwdfrydedd ac egni a gafodd ei hyfforddi yn Ysgol Manceinion ac Ysgol yr Academi Frenhinol, roedd yn arddangos ei waith yn eang ac yn ddiweddarach daeth yn Lywydd ar Academi Celfyddyd Gain Manceinion. Yn 1998, aeth arddangosfa o'i waith, a ysgogwyd gan Lyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru, gyda Peter Lord a David Mortimer-Jones yn guraduriaid, ar daith ar hyd a lled Cymru, gan orffen yn yr Academi Frenhinol Gymreig yng Nghonwy. Bu'n gyfle i genhedaeth newydd weld llawer o'i baentiau olew a dyfrlliw pwerus.

Y Llywydd nesaf oedd Syr Cuthbert Grundy, ac yn ystod ei 21 mlynedd yn llywydd parhaodd yr Arddangosfa Haf Flynyddol ar raddfa fawr, gan ddenu cefnogaeth eang a gwerthu'n dda, er bod yr arddangosfeydd yn cael eu beirniadu'n aml yn y wasg am beidio â bod yn rhwng fentrus iawn! Comisiynodd Grundy fedalwn cofa i ddathlu hanner can mlwyddiant yr Academi yn 1932. Pan ymddeolodd yn 1934, daeth Augustus John yn llywydd. Fodd bynnag, ar ôl bod yn bresennol i gael ei ethol, gan fod bywyd â chymaint i'w gynnig mewn mannau eraill ni fynychodd yr un cyfarfod arall byth wedyn. Disodlwyd ef gan Richard Hinchcliffe yn 1939. Unionwyd y sefyllfa, fodd bynnag, yn 1997, pan agorodd arddangosfa yn Llundain o luniau John, wedi'i rhoi at ei gilydd gan ei wyres, Rebecca John AFG, Orielau Cenedlaethol Cymru a Spinks, oriel yn Llundain, cyn mynd ar daith yng Nghymru. Yr Academi Frenhinol Gymreig oedd lleoliad olaf yr arddangosfa, a bu'n llwyddiant ysgubol yma gan ddenu miloedd o ymwelwyr.

Dros y blynnyddoedd nesaf gwelwyd menywod ar y Cyngor, daeth EM y Fam Frenhines yn noddwr brenhinol yn 1952 a chynhalwyd yr Arddangosfeydd Haf Blynnyddol llwyddiannus arferol. Fodd bynnag, roedd costau uchel cynnal a chadw Plas Mawr wedi mynd yn dreth ar yr Academi ac roedd angen gwneud newidiadau. Yn 1972, ceisiodd y Llywydd, Kyrion Williams, annog yr Academyddion i symud allan o Blas Mawr, ac yntau wedi sicrhau Oriel Mostyn yn Llandudno fel canolfan newydd. Er gwaethaf manteision lu y symudiad hwn, methodd â pherswadio'r Academyddion ac ymddiswyddodd mewn protest.

Yn 1991 agorwyd Twnnel Conwy a golygai hyn newidiadau i bawb o fewn muriau Conwy. Gyda diflaniad y tagfeidd traffig, roedd yna gyfle penigamp i Gonwy groesawu ymwelwyr mewn awrygylch tawel, rhywbeth na chafwyd mohono o gwbl bron dros y deng mlynedd ar hugain cyn hynn. Cynhalwyd trafodaethau rhwng Cadw, yr Arglwydd Mostyn a'r Academi gyda golwg ar drosolwyddo tenantiaeth Plas Mawr i Cadw, a dreuliodd ddwy flynedd yn adnewyddu'r adeilad cyn ei ailagor i'r cyhoedd fel engraiiff ragorol o blasty tref Elisabethaidd. Drws nesaf i Oriel Fictoria roedd capel, Capel Seion, a oedd yn wag ac mewn cylfr truenus. Ar ôl trafodaethau hirfaith rhwng yr AFG, yn gweithio gyda'r pensaer Skip Belton, Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy, Geoffrey Edwards o Brosiect Conwy, Cadw a Bwrdd Croeso Cymru, crëwyd oriel newydd bwrpasol. Agorodd ei harddangosfa gyntaf ar Fehafin y 12fed 1993.

Gyda'r symud daeth newidiadau eraill. Ymddiswyddodd Ray Fields fel Llywydd yn 1992, ar ôl bod yn y swydd er 1983, ac, ar ôl cyfnod o drawsnewid i'r Academi o dan arweiniad David Hillhouse, ymgymroedd Kyffin Williams â'r llywyddiaeth am yr ail waith. Ym 1993 ymunais a'r Academi fel Curadur ar ôl i Sylvia a Leonard Mercer ymddeol. Aeth y Llywydd a Cyngor newydd ati i ddenu arlunwyr o bob rhan o Gymru i ymaelodi, gan ganolbwytio ar y De a'r Canolbarth, a chynyddodd nifer yr

aelodau i dros gant. Cyflwynodd ef a'r Cyngor raglen o naw arddangosfa y flwyddyn. Lluniwyd cysylltiadau newydd gydag orielau eraill yng Nghymru ac, am y tro cyntaf ers blynnyddoedd lawer, anfonodd yr Academi arddangosfa i Amgueddfeydd ac Orielau Cymru yng Nghaerdydd. Ymatebasant hwythau drwy ganiatâu i gasgliadau pwysig ddod i Gonwy, fel a wnaeth Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru. Sefydlywd grŵp newydd, 'Cyfeillion yr AFG', gyda help ac arweiniad Anne Forrest, Lauren Lindee a'r cadeirydd, Michael Senior. Mae cefnogaeth y Cyfeillion wedi bod yn amhrisiadwy ac mae'r arian a godwyd ganddynt wedi cael ei fuddsoddi'n ôl yn yr oriel mewn llu o ffyrdd gwahanol er mwyn gwella'r rhaglenni arddangos a'r rhaglenni addysgol.

Erbyn hyn mae gan yr Academi raglen arddangos gydol y flwyddyn ac mae'r oriel, gyda'i darpariaeth eang a chain, hefyd yn lleoliad rhagorol ar gyfer darlithoedd, lansio llyfrau a sioeau sleidiau. Mae pob arddangosiad preifat yn denu o leiaf 100 o bobl a phob arddangosfa, ar gyfartaledd, yn denu bron i 2000 o ymwelwyr. Ceir nawdd gan Gyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy, Cyngor Tref Conwy, Cyngor Celfyddydau Cymru, rhai ymddiriedolaethau lleol bach ond hael ac, wrth gwrs, yr Academi ei hun.
